StepBridge National Teams Competition for Members

StepBridge members are invited to nominate for a National Teams Competition. Teams of four, representing each State in Australia will play against others teams representing the other States. A captain will be designated for each team.

Anyone may nominate and the teams are preferably ranked according to the more accomplished players from each State. Negotiations may occur with the Organiser regarding partnerships.

Note: If you are aware of accomplished players within your State you may invite them to become StepBridge Members to enable them to participate in the event.

Fourteen Board Matches will be played, outside of the normal StepBridge session times. As that will be 28 boards, at least 2 to 3 hours needs to be scheduled for each event. Captains will be nominated from each team and when the allocation of teams is made the Captain will be responsible for arranging the match between themselves and opponents. The organiser will provide scheduling times. You will have four weeks to complete the match and inform the organiser of the outcome. Subsequent winners will then be allocated to the next match to be played.

A final of the top teams will be arranged and advertised to the members.

No fees will be charged and the Committee has allocated 500 participation points to each member of the winning team and 250 participation points to the runner up team members.

Recipe Corner

Creamy Vegetable Pesto Bake Brenda McClean (Brenda)

Ingredients

500g packet frozen vegies.

(I use fresh vegies and frozen beans and peas. Make sure they are cooked through. Also use sliced potatoes)

- 2 tablespoons of plain flour
- 2 tablespoons of basil pesto
- 300 millilitres of cream for cooking
- 3/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
- 1/3 cup mozzarella or cheddar cheese
- 1/4 cup panko breadcrumbs

Chopped parsley to serve.

Method

- 1. Preheat oven to 200C/180C fan-forced.
- 2. Combine vegies with flour. Toss to combine.
- Whisk cream, pesto and 1/2 cup parmesan in a jug or bowl. Pour over vegetables in dish.
- 4. Combine remaining parmesan, mozzarella / cheddar and breadcrumbs. Sprinkle over vegetables.
- 5. Bake for 20 minutes or until heated through and top is golden and crunchy. Serve topped with parsley.
