Our membership has grown to 115 Home Club members and approximately 1950 Associate Members. We have processed 120 new applications so far this year. In December we hosted 2670 tables and in January 2983 tables, so as you can see despite face to face clubs resuming play, our numbers are quite steady. Brown sticker conventions and Yellow (HUM) systems are banned from StepBridge. This includes Myxomatosis Two's &Optimal Two bids. Please update your system card accordingly. CHICKEN PIE

Brenda has given us a very nice recipe to share with like minded people.

2 Chicken fillets, sliced

375ml can evaporated milk

1 cup chicken stock

3 tbsp. butter

3 tbsp. plain flour

1 cup peas

1 large carrot diced

1 medium onion diced

puff pastry sheets



- 1. Cook chicken and set aside.
- 2. Prepare pie dish lined with pastry sheet.
- 3. Simmer onion, carrots peas in the stock till cooked. Drain the vegies BUT KEEP the stock you drain.
- 4. Melt butter in saucepan, add flour and combine. Gradually add evaporated milk and the drained stock, Bring to the boil and simmer gently. Stir in the vegies and chicken and pour into the pastry shell.
- 5. Top with pastry, and brush with milk.
- 6. Cook at 180 for 1 hour.

- Check Your Participation Points balance and transactions


There will be also be some other features, which are currently being developed and will be released in first couple of months of 2021.


To access the Portal, please do the following


- 3. Once you have logged in to the Portal, you have another of options in the left hand column.

NEW PROCESS FOR PURCHASING PARTICIPATION POINTS

StepBridge is introducing a new process for purchasing participation points. This new process will mean that you will never be short of enough Participation Points to play in a StepBridge tournament.


Below are step by step instructions of how to purchase your Participation Points with this new process.

1. Login to the StepBridge Club (playing platform) as if you were going to play in a tournament. Select a session and then click on the Shopping Cart image.




NEW PROCESS FOR PURCHASING PARTICIPATION POINTS (cont.)

2. The following screen will then pop up. You have the option of choosing the amount of Participation Points you wish to purchase and the amount it will cost.



3. The pop up screen will then change the following, in which you are asked to confirm you purchase of Participation Points. Once you please confirm on this screen, you will receive a confirmation email to the email address we have on our database. This confirmation email will have payment instructions, including a unique reference number.

One of the things I love about StepBridge is that there are fewer opportunities for players to make insensitive or gloating comments, especially as scores are not shown until the next round

The Laws of Bridge are supportive of courteous behaviour and encouraging the promotion of enjoyment for all participants

I've noticed some players are getting a little carried away with their enthusiasm to proclaim a triumphant board. Whilst it is appropriate to commend partners (and opposition) on skilful play, it is downright rude to crow when opps make a defensive error that results in partner making an unmakeable contract or makes a good sacrifice. It is also completely unnecessary to comment "VWP" on a board where contract was never in any doubt! Or, to making such comments EVERY time partner plays a board. Private chat between rounds gives everyone an opportunity to cheer without offending anyone.

Overall, I've found most players are very courteous and many will compliment their opposition, and this encourages others to do the same. However, I've noticed a lot more unnecessary "gloating". It is offensive.

I hope the Directors can make some timely comments reminding players of their obligation to ensure that everyone enjoys the game and refrain from comments that are poor etiquette.


