Dear Members,

StepBridge has seen another very busy month with more player enhancements and back-end processing improvements coming on line every day. We have had a couple of hiccups along the way which are inevitable when we

introduce new procedures and changes to our software, however we are confident these matters have been resolved. Our server for both the playing platform and our website have been relocated to Australia and this relocation has take a few days to settle. Players are reporting much faster speeds and we are encouraged that this relocation will prove to be of benefit to all. The results email is handled a little differently now and at times maybe delayed a short time. If you are anxious to review your results you can always go to the website to check them out.

Membership numbers continue to grow which is really good to see with face to face clubs also returning to play.

In our quest to ensure that StepBridge players play in a fair and just environment, we have appointed a Player's Jury. This panel is made up of players representing each State and ACT. Their task will be to examine complaints or play referred to the panel for consideration that is deemed to be unjustified bidding/play. The Jury will reach a decision and report to our Committee where a decision as to penalties will be made. The guidelines will be added to the member's page on our website.

The automated membership participation points process is working well. We have included the procedure in the newsletter again for those of you still unsure of how it works. Please make sure you follow the new process and you will have your points available instantly and the saving in processing time for our team is considerable.



March 2021

WARM PEACH AND ALMOND DESSERT CAKE

Megan made this at the weekend and all thought it was delish!

INGREDIENTS

- Two peaches, sliced
- 150gm butter softened
- 3/4 cup castor sugar
- 3 lightly beaten eggs
- 1.5 cups almond meal
- 1/2 cup plain flour
- 1/2 cup self raising flour
- 3/4 cup thickened cream
- 3/4 cup frozen raspberries
- 1/3 cup flaked almonds

METHOD

- 1. Preheat the oven to 180°. Grease a pan (preferably a springform cake pan)
- 2. Using an electric mixer beat the sugar and the butter together until light and fluffy. At the eggs, one at a time beating well until mixed (don't panic if the mixture looks a little curdled)
- 3. Add the almond meal, flours and custard
- 4. Spread the mixture into the prepared pan and then arrange and press the peach slices into the top as well as the raspberries. Sprinkle the flaked almonds on top and bake for about 40 mins.
- 5. Serve warm and enjoy with cream, ice cream or custard.



ABF MASTERPOINTS NEWS

1000 Club

The ABF Council have confirmed a recommendation that players who have earned 1000+ masterpoints, irrespective of the colour of the masterpoints, be recognised. These players will be awarded a certificate designating the player as a member of the 'One Thousand Club'.

Players who achieve 1000+ masterpoints, providing they do not achieve the rank of Grand Master at the same time, will receive this recognition. Otherwise, they will simply receive their Grand Master certificate.

Note: The 1000 Club is purely a recognition certificate, not a new Master rank.

Star(*) Master Ranks

Some of the Master Ranks previously were denoted by either 1-star (*) or 2-star (**) rankings. To bring the nomenclature in line with that used for Life and Grand Masters, the ABF have renamed the 1-star (*) ranks as Bronze, and the 2-star (**) ranks as Silver.
