

#### **Director's Corner**

#### What conventions are not allowed?

We allow most conventional Bids in our games on StepBridge but there are a few that are disallowed because competing against them requires a specialised defence that would put most players at a disadvantage. Our games, outside of Congresses, are intended to be friendly rather than cut-throat competition, so your opponents are not allowed to use these methods.



When you log in to StepBridge at the bottom of the notice is the following statement:

The only approved systems are Green, Blue, & Red for Open sessions, and Green & Blue for Novice & Restricted sessions. Brown sticker conventions and Yellow (HUM) systems are banned. This includes Myxomatosis Twos and Optimal Two bids.

So what does that mean?

**Green** systems are ones in which opening 1-level bids promise the suit bid: at least four cards in a Major; three in Diamonds; and two in Clubs.

Blue systems have a strong one Club (or occasionally Diamond) any distribution, and natural Majors. **Red** systems may open one Club with one or no Clubs – these cannot be used in our Novice or Restricted games.

**Brown** sticker conventions are what typically cause confusion. These include:

- 1. Opening bids between 2C and 3S inclusive that have weak options that do not promise at least four cards in a known suit (often called the anchor suit).
- 2. Overcalls of a natural opening bid of one of a suit that do not have an anchor suit.

An example of (1) is a Myxomatosis 2D opening bid which means: strong Diamonds, weak Hearts, or weak 5-5 in Spades and Clubs.

An example of (2) is a TWERB 1D overcall of a natural 1C meaning long Hearts or 5-5 in Spades and Clubs.


Many people play a Multi-2D meaning a weak six-card unspecified Major. There is an exception that allows this bid **not** to have an anchor suit. Note that opening bids of 3NT and above are not restricted so, for example, a Gambling 3NT showing a solid unspecified minor is also OK.

Since a strong 1C opening is **not** a natural opening bid, there are no restrictions on overcalls so a TWERB 1D would be OK. Similarly there are no restrictions on overcalls of 1NT: as you are probably aware there are endless conventions on how to defend against an opening 1NT.

Finally, what do you do if you suspect an opponent has used a disallowed convention? As always, if there is an infraction, call the TD. If their convention is not allowed you will get a major advantage: the offending opponent must substitute a comparable bid (which probably doesn't exist), or their partner must pass whenever it is their turn to bid. In addition the information from the disallowed bid is authorised to you, but it is unauthorised to their partner. If you don't recognise the disallowed convention until the end of the hand, you should still call the TD – they have the power to award an adjusted score if your side is damaged by opponents using a disallowed convention.






## **UPDATE** Gold Coast Congress: StepBridge Hospitality Event
