Director's Corner: An Insight Into Directing

As a regular Bridge player you will already know certain things about at least some of your opponents. There are those who are a pleasure to play against even if they beat you. There are those who you would be happy never to see again. Some are annoying or do annoying things. Some you would be happy to socialise with. There are even those who you swear must be cheating 😡



As a TD these opinions are magnified ten-fold. Face-to-face or Online Directors often know before the session starts what to expect from certain players. Who is going to be: slow; complaining; criticising; winning; friendly; challenging; and so on. We have seen repeat performances, often many times, by the very same players!

An opinion is a great thing to have. Everyone has one, a bit like the nose on your face. But not all opinions are helpful. Indeed most, *especially* those that you relate to as "facts" rather than mere opinions, get in the way of objective decision making and optimal communication. Hence we train our TDs to set their opinions aside when answering a Call or Question from a player. The TDs job is to arrive at a Table with fresh eyes and ears, reach a calm and equitable conclusion, and communicate that clearly to all concerned. Our TDs are, of course, human, so achieving this Gold Standard of rising above their opinions may not always be achieved...

Let's say **JRotten** on Table 7 calls the TD. It's his fourth call this session. He does this every session. He says "North hasn't explained his bid properly — no point count". This, or a version of this, is what he always complains about. You have told him on numerous occasions that if it doesn't affect his bid it does not matter and, if his side is damaged by a lack of information, he should call you back at the end of the hand. As the TD, how should you now respond?

A natural, human reaction would be to begin with something polite like *"I have already told you Mr Rotten that ..."*. But that would be letting your opinion (backed up by your list of "facts" about **JRotten**) run the show. The best TD response will be exactly the same as if the call came from **AngelG**, a delightful angelic player, whom you have never before heard complain about anything!

Our TDs may not always treat you like **AngelG**. They might let an opinion get in the way. They might be stressed, frustrated, be having a "bad hair day", or whatever. They are human, just like you, your partner, and your opponents. And, of course, you are entitled to your *own* opinion about your TD and any particular interaction.

StepBridge is committed to having the best possible environment for our players to enjoy Bridge. Hence we train our TDs to set their opinions aside. One way they do that is to communicate with other TDs about any issues that arise in a session. We don't expect our players to set their opinions aside (even if it might be a good idea), but we *do* request that you communicate any strong opinions to your TD or support@stepbridge.com.au

Naturally we *love* positive opinions and compliments, as would you, your partner, and your opponents, so feel free to express these publicly 🥰 We encourage you, however, to also express negative opinions or complaints: do so **in private** to your TD (or to admin if it is about the TD!). This will allow us to recognise issues with players or directing, and to attempt to address them before they become major.

We want to hear about even *little* "niggles". The sort of irritations that "don't really matter" but that can affect your overall experience of playing on StepBridge. Being aware of any such niggles will help us improve matters. Not letting us know may let things fester so that *those* players or **that** TD become a serious problem — just the way "it is" and a "fact" that cannot be changed 😞

Cookery Corner

Crispy Salmon Patties

Ingredients

- 1 large potato (300g) cooked and mashed
- 1 medium onion finely chopped
- 415g can pink salmon
- Clove crushed garlic
- 2 teasp. Parsley chopped
- 2 eggs
- Salt and pepper
- ¼ cup plain flour
- ⅔ cup panko breadcrumbs



Directions

1. Drain the salmon, lightly fry the onion and garlic and put everything in together and mix well.
2. Roll into patties and put in fridge for half hour.
3. Little olive oil hot in pan, and fry for about 2 minutes on each side.
4. Serve with fresh salad and garlic bread.

Tiramisu

Ingredients

- 1 ½ table spoon of instant coffee granules
- 1 cup Kahlua or Tia Maria liquor
- 300ml thickened cream
- 40g icing sugar
- 250g sweet sponge finger biscuits
- 500g mascarpone cheese

Method

1. Combine coffee, 1 1/4 cups hot water and 2/3 cup liqueur in a shallow bowl, stirring to dissolve coffee granules. Refrigerate until needed.
2. Meanwhile, whip cream with icing sugar. Add mascarpone and remaining liqueur and stir well to combine.
3. Dip half the biscuits, one at a time, into coffee mixture for a few seconds, then place in a single layer at the bottom of a 20cm square serving dish. Spread with half the cream mixture. Repeat with remaining biscuits, and coffee and cream mixtures. Dust with cocoa and chill for 2 hours or overnight. Serve.
