## Cookery Corner

Thank you to Brenda McClean (Brenda) for our monthly Cookery Corner.

### Seafood Bok Choy

#### Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon of sesame oil
- 1 tablespoon of extra virgin olive oil
- 1 tablespoon of butter
- Bunch of bok choy, roughly chopped
- 1 carrot, sliced julienne, handful of beans & 1 large onion thinly sliced, steam together until al dente
- 4 cloves of garlic, crushed
- Handful of shitake mushrooms (soak in cold water overnight)
- 2 tablespoons of grated ginger
- 1/2 packet of marinara seafood mix
- 1 cup of stock
- 2 tablespoons of oyster sauce
- 2 tablespoons of soy sauce
- Corn flour



#### Directions

- In large pan put the tablespoon of sesame and tablespoon of extra virgin olive oil
- And the tablespoon of Butter, garlic and ginger, and simmer
- Add the onions, and cook gently.
- Add the mushrooms and the al dente vegies.
- Add the stock and stir well.
- Add the marinara mix and simmer for 8-10 minutes
- Lastly add the sauces and bok choy, and simmer for just a couple of minutes
- Add a little corn flour with cold water to thicken
- Season with salt and pepper.

### Lemon Drizzle Cake

#### Ingredients - Cake

- 200g of butter
- 200g of castor sugar
- 4 eggs, separated
- 175g of ground almond
- 250g of mashed potato
- Zest from 3 lemons
- 2 teaspoons of baking powder

#### Ingredients - Drizzle

- 4 tablespoon of sugar
- Juice of 1 lemon
- Grated lemon rind



#### Directions

Heat oven to 180c. Grease 20cm round cake tin

Beat butter and sugar till fluffy, then add eggs gradually, beating after each addition.

Fold in the almond, potato, zest and baking powder.

Pour into tin, bake 40 - 45 minutes.

Cool. Then mix sugar and lemon together, and pour over decorating with the rind.
