

# **Honey and Bacon Meatloaf**

#### Ingredients

- 2 lb. lean ground beef
- 1 small minced onion
- 1 small minced stalk celery
- 1 small minced carrot, minced
- 1 c. finely ground bread crumbs
- 1/2 c. Honey and mustard dipping sauce (divided)
- 1/4 c. freshly chopped parsley
- 2 large eggs
- 1/2 tsp. garlic powder
- 1 tbsp. kosher salt
- 1/2 tsp. freshly ground black pepper
- 12-14 slices thin bacon



#### **Directions**

Put all ingredients except bacon in basin, keeping half mustard and honey sauce, and use hands to mulch it in together.

Put into a greased loaf tin, arrange slices bacon across top, and then weave more rashers cross wise.

Cook at 375c for one hour, then pour remainder of sauce over top. Cook then for a further half hour.

## No Cook Mini Chocolate Cheesecakes

#### Ingredients - Cheesecake

- Packet of Orio biscuits, crushed
- 2 tables spoons of melted butter
- 8 ozs of cream cheese
- Half cup of sugar
- 1 teaspoon of cornfour
- Vanilla essence
- 200g of chocolate
- 1 egg
- 1 tablespoon of cream

#### Ingredients - Ganache

120ml of cream 120g of chocolate half teaspoon of oil



#### **Directions - Cheesecake**

Press in together the crushed Orio biscuits and melted butter into patty pans. Refrigerate.

Beat together cream cheese, sugar, cornfour and vanilla essence.

Melt 200g of chocolate 200g and cool it. Whisk with an egg and 1 tablespoon of cream. Pipe it into the patty pans.

#### Directions - Ganache

Beat ingredients, put on top of the other mixture, and refrigerate well.

# **Holiday Blogs**

### Sarah's Turkish Adventures - continued

Hello from Düzce. Where we have been besieged with earthquakes for the past 2 weeks.

Being a Kiwi born Australian I certainly have vivid memories of earthquakes aplenty in NZ. The past two weeks have been an unpleasant reminder.

We had quite a big earthquake centred about 15 kilometres from us. Woke us up at 4.08am. Ironically the week before there was a national earthquake drill to remind people of procedures and protocols. Somewhat timely. We spent 5 hours outside of the house in the garden mostly in the dark and cold. We lit a firepit and had tea brewing on the gas burner. Orhan and I were wrapped up like Eskimos against the cold. There was significant damage to a number of buildings and more than 50 people injured. Now nearly 2 weeks later there is still a tent city set up in a variety of locations for those unable to return to their homes. Fortunately our construction has stood the earthquake test and we are maybe 3 weeks away from occupation.

The weather has been dull and cool and quite wet, so very soggy around the site. The kitchen will be installed tomorrow, and we have been lighting the fire every day, so the house is cosy and warm. Next blog I hope to have lots of pictures for you.
