2025 ABF Club Teams Knockout

StepBridge will be sending a team for each category of the 2025 ABF Club Teams Knockout.

For this to occur, StepBridge will have its own club qualifying as part of our Monday 8pm Teams on 23 June, 30 June, 7 July and 14 July. To qualify, the team would have to play 3 out of 4 Monday nights.

At the end of the 4 weeks, teams who have played at least 3 out of 4 weeks would then be offered a spot, beginning with first place. The team who came first would be offered the Open division, unless they were eligible for a lower division and wished to compete in the lower division. The same would continue until all divisions are filled.

By the team accepting a spot to play in the ABF Club Teams Knockout Qualifying, they must be available for the 5 Tuesday nights (once per month) between July and November.

StepBridge will pay the \$200 entry fee for the 5 teams representing StepBridge in the ABF Club Teams Knockout. So get your team together and play in June and July to see if you can qualify.
