
Message from the President

- Note: This feature is still being developed.
 Currently, you cannot select a system card or receive explanations of bidding systems.
- Open a recreational table and leave one or more seats empty.
- Use the "Play with Sabi" button to fill all empty seats with Sabi.
- Choose your arrangement freely: play with three
 Sabis, with your partner against Sabi, or against each other with Sabi as your partner.



If you're playing with Sabi as your partner and become dummy, you will play as dummy.

The name Sabi could stand for Step Artificial Bridge Intelligence, but mostly it's simply a pleasant name for a friendly bridge robot.

ABF Registration Cards

The ABF Masterpoint Centre have moved with the times!

Conditions of Entry

- All players MUST be either a Home Club Member or Associate Member of StepBridge Australia (No Trial Memberships will be eligible).
- Approved Gold Masterpoint Event conducted under the Laws of Duplicate Bridge and SABF regulations.
- Masterpoints not guaranteed unless ABF number is provided.
- Green, blue & red systems, and Brown Sticker conventions and treatments permitted.
- No Yellow (HUM) systems.
- Each pair must have 2 systemically identical current system cards. Players are responsible for ensuring their system classification is correct.
- Audio Video will be used. Players are responsible for ensuring their Audio Video works.
- Teams must nominate either as a contending or non-contending team by the commencement of play.
- Contending teams must all be South Australia residents and be prepared to play in the SABF Under 1500 and Regional GNOT Final if they qualify.
- SABF Under 1500 and Regional GNOT will be held on Sunday 24 August 2025 in Adelaide (Venue TBA).

Closing Date

Thursday 31st July 2025, 5.00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time.

- 600 Participation Points per Player. Select "Club PP System" in MyABF for payment method.
- The Participation Points will be deducted from your account on the day of the congress. Please ensure you have enough Participation Points in your account.

Willem Willemse Club Championships

StepBridge will be holding its fourth annual Club Championships during the month of September. It has been decided to name our Club Championships after **Willem Willemse**, who introduced StepBridge to Australia in 2004.

Red masterpoints will be awarded to the top half of each session as well as the top third for those who qualify for the championship. There will be the five categories of Open Pairs, Open Individual, Open Teams, Restricted Pairs (under 300 masterpoints) and Novice Pairs (100 masterpoints) played at the following times:

Open Teams

Mondays 1, 8, 15 & 22 September - 8:00pm session (Audio-Video)

Open Individual

Saturdays 6, 13, 20 & 27 September - 10:00am session (Audio-Video)

Open Pairs & Restricted Pairs

Sundays 7, 14, 21 & 28 September - 2:30pm session (Audio-Video)

Novice Pairs

Tuesdays 2, 9, 16 & 23 September - 7:50pm session (Audio-Video)

For the Restricted and Novice categories, the cut-off for eligibility is as of 31 August 2025.

The cost will be 100 PPs per person, per session.

To qualify for a category, you need to play at least 3 out of the 4 sessions. Your best 3 results will be combined and averaged.

For the pairs session, you need to play with the same partner to qualify.

For the teams session, you need to play with the same team of four to qualify (no subtilties or teams of 5 & 6 players).

The championship in each category will be awarded to the team/pair/individual with the highest average.

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each category:

1st = 2,500 PPs (Pair / Team share the prize)

2nd = 1,000 PPs (Pair / Team share the prize)

3rd = 500 PPs (Pair / Team share the prize)
