## **ANNUAL REPORT - PRESIDENT for Financial Year Ending June 2025**

StepBridge continues to experience new players and returning players joining and rejoining our club and enjoying our style of online bridge. We currently have 2077 paid up members, of which 283 are Home Club Members, participating in the 47 regularly scheduled tournaments every week. Among our members we have 25 who are aged 90 years and older with VIP Status and 31 who are Youth Players.

This year we continued to host two clubs in our Virtual Club rooms to enable them to a mix of face-to-face and online sessions in their Club Programmes. One Virtual Club runs all-year round and the other runs in the winter months.

We held our first Club GNOT Heat this year. This was possible due to the collaboration with the SABF to obtain permission from the ABF to hold a Heat. This should continue in our yearly calendar for years to come.

We continue to regularly hold Audio-Video sessions with our Sunday Afternoon All Around Australia Red Masterpoint Session, Monday evening Teams session, our all-day Congresses & GNOT Heat, as well as any other special events such as Melbourne Cup Day & the SABF State-Wide Pairs.

A new completely redesigned version of our StepBridge playing platform is currently available and is running alongside the older familiar version that has been in existence for many years. Enhancements and improvements continue to be released, eventually leading to a complete transition to the new platform. The introduction of SABI, our AI bridge robot, is a popular addition to your StepBridge experience

The Committee over the last year has developed a Player Code of Conduct Policy & Procedures and a 2025-2030 Strategic Plan. We are also in the process of developing a bridge education program with lessons. Watch this space!

### **DIRECTORS**

Thank you to our StepBridge Tournament Director Team, looked after by our Head TD Sarah Zoral, for their contribution and support to our players over the past 12 months. This year we have welcomed three Tournament Directors to the team, to share the load. The Tournament Director Team have looked after our regular sessions as well as the Congresses hosted by StepBridge, which has involved 108,780 players. This is slight decrease of 5,302 players from 114,082 players in 2023-2024 Financial Year.
